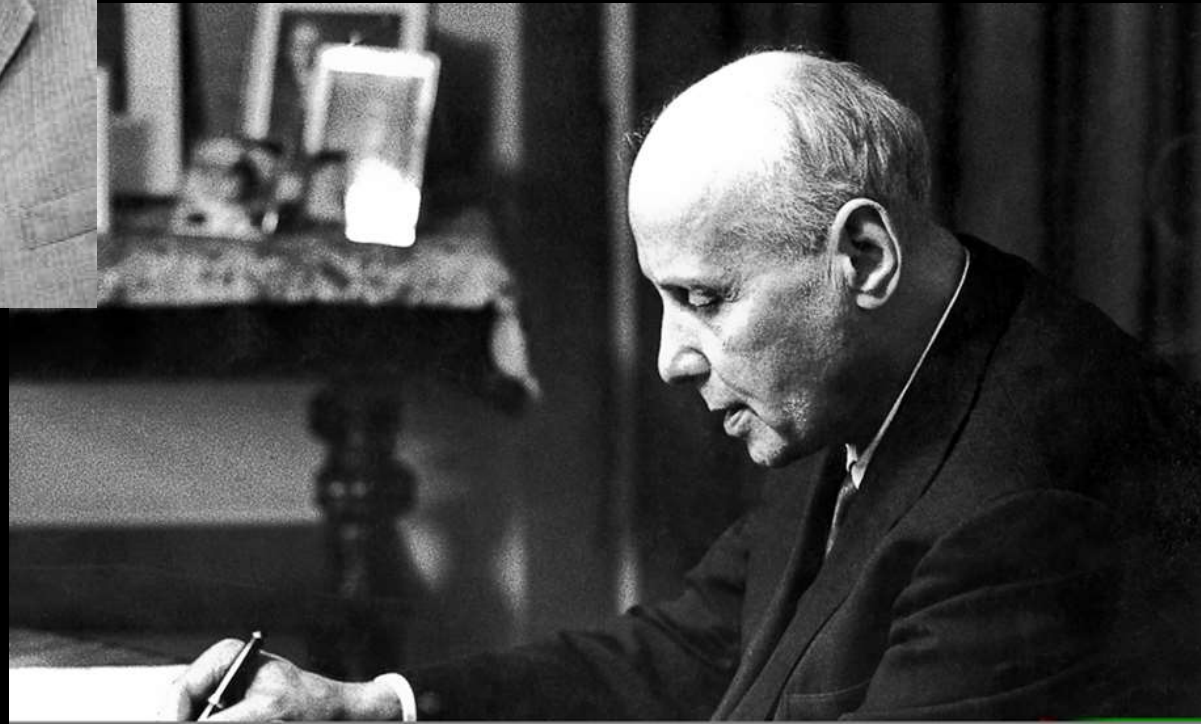
# Lifeboats

- During World War II, young merchant seamen were not surviving as well as their older counterparts in lifeboat situations, after their ships had been torpedoed by German submarines.
- Hahn figured out why: that the younger sailors had not enough life experience. What's more, the old sailors had been brought up in an age of sail, and learnt lots of practical skills and dealt with difficult situations before, giving them more confidence and ability to cope with demanding challenges.

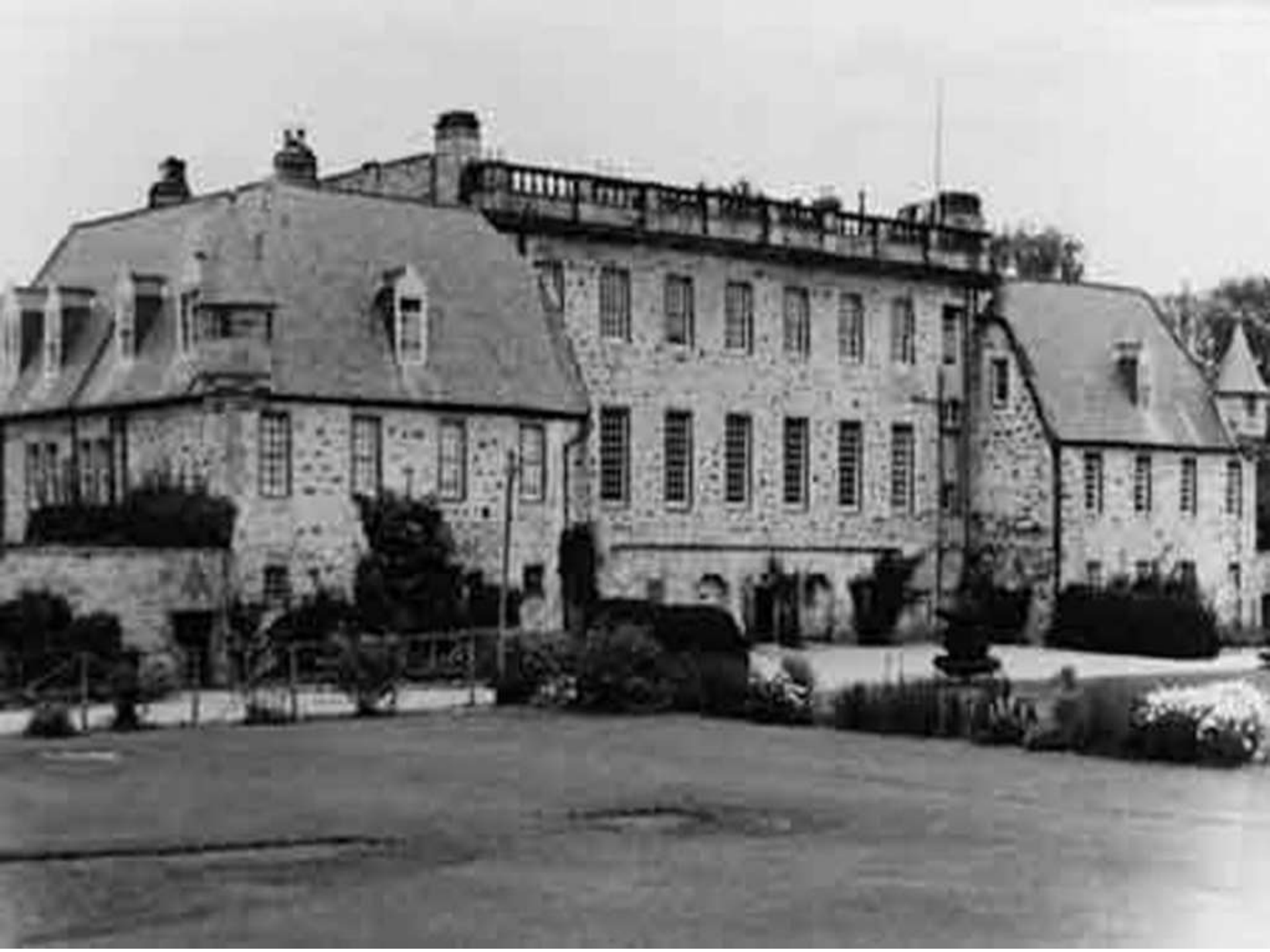




# Early Years

- Gordonstoun

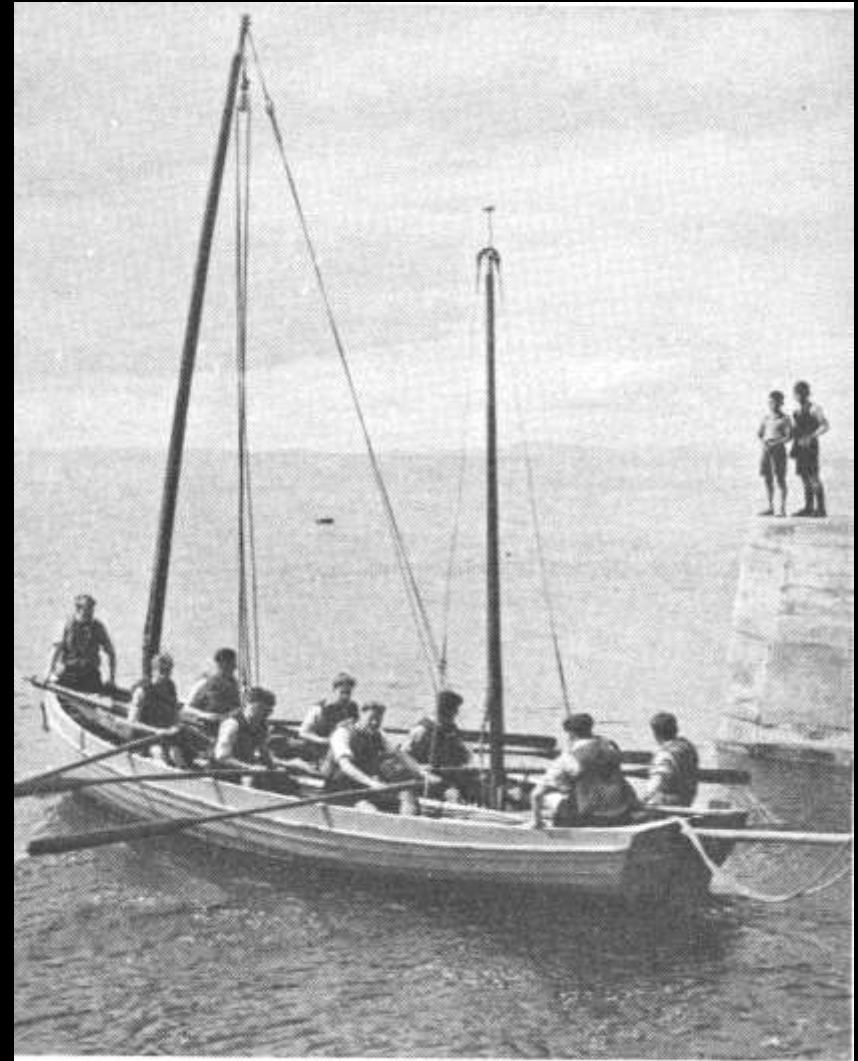
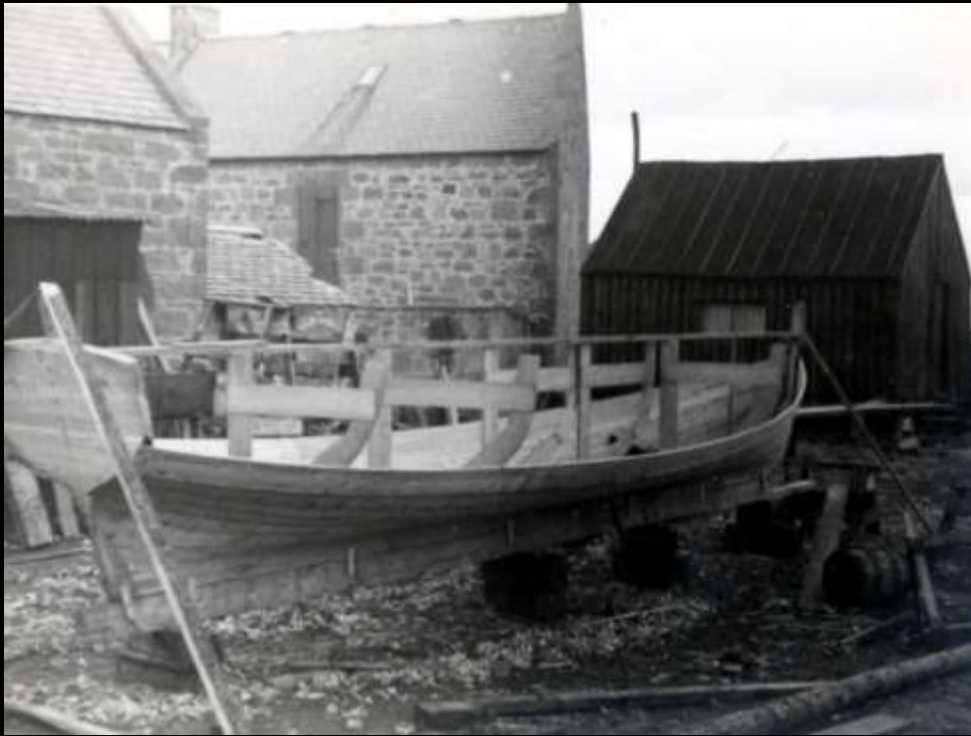
